Romeo and Juliet

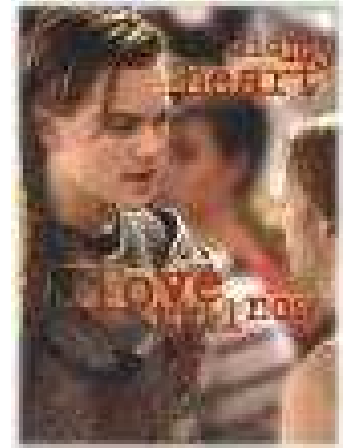
